Description

The opportunity

A UK organisation is seeking a Non-Executive Director with genuine depth in environmental, social and governance (ESG) and sustainability to strengthen its board's oversight in this increasingly central area. As sustainability moves from a reporting obligation to a strategic and commercial issue — shaping investor expectations, regulatory exposure, supply-chain risk and long-term value — boards are seeking directors who can bring informed, independent judgement to it rather than treating it as a peripheral concern.

This is a governance appointment. The role is to provide oversight and constructive challenge on the organisation's ESG strategy, sustainability commitments and related risks and reporting — not to run the sustainability function, which remains the responsibility of management. The successful candidate will translate real ESG expertise into effective board-level contribution, and will serve as a full member of the board across all its responsibilities.

- Providing the board with informed oversight of the organisation's ESG and sustainability strategy, and its alignment with the wider business strategy
- Bringing independent challenge to sustainability commitments, targets and the credibility of the plans to meet them — guarding against both under-ambition and greenwashing
- Overseeing the organisation's approach to climate and environmental risk, and its integration into the board's wider risk management
- Contributing board-level perspective on social and governance factors, stakeholder expectations and reputational considerations
- Overseeing the integrity and rigour of sustainability reporting and disclosure, as regulatory and investor expectations continue to develop
- Contributing as a full member of the board to strategy, performance oversight and constructive challenge across all matters, and serving on relevant committees
- Upholding independence and the standards of governance expected of a non-executive director
